EXECUTIVE ORDER TERMINATING PARISH-WIDE CURFEW ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH THE STATE OF EMERGENCY AS PER THE LOUISIANA HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE AND DISASTER ACT, LA. REV. STAT. 29:721, ET SEQ., AS TO THE EFFECTS OF HURRICANE IDA.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act, La. Rev. Stat. 29:721, et seq., confers upon the Governor of the State of Louisiana and parish presidents emergency powers to prepare and cope with emergencies and disasters, including those caused by fire, flood, earthquake or other natural or manmade causes, in order to ensure that preparations will be adequate to cope with such emergencies or disasters and to preserve the lives and property of the people of the State of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, when the Parish President determines that a disaster or emergency has occurred, or the threat thereof is imminent, La. Rev. Stat. 29:727 empowers him to declare a state of emergency by executive order or proclamation; and

WHEREAS, La. Rev. Stat. 29:727(F) authorizes the Parish President to, among other things, control ingress and egress to and from the affected area, the movement of persons within the area, and the occupancy of premises therein; and

WHEREAS, on August 26, 2021, Governor Edwards issued Executive Proclamation No. 165 JBE 2021 declaring a state of emergency as to the impending onset of the storm; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2021, Michael B. Cooper, as Parish President of St. Tammany Parish, issued an Executive Order declaring a state of emergency as to the storm; and

WHEREAS, on August 29, 2021, Parish President Cooper issued an Executive Order establishing a Parish-wide curfew commencing at noon on August 29, 2021, due to the immediate threat to life and property caused by Hurricane Ida, as authorized pursuant to the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act, La. Rev. Stat. 29:721, et seq., specifically La. Rev. Stat. 29:727(F)(7); and


WHEREAS, Hurricane Ida no longer poses an immediate threat to life and property.

IT IS ORDERED that the Parish-wide curfew established by Executive Order on August 29, 2021, is hereby terminated.
